Regulations

The Shipping Agent (Licensing) Regulations, 1991, published in Gazette Extraordinary No.684/9 of October 17, 1991, as amended by Gazette Extraordinary No. 905/13 of January 12, 1996 are hereby further amended by the repeal of regulation 8 thereof and the substitution therefore of the following regulation with effect from 14.11.2006.

- "8.**
- (1) The annual fee payable for a licence by a Shipping Agent representing ten principals or less shall be thirty five thousand rupees in respect of a public or private company and for every additional principal, at the rate of five hundred rupees.
 - (2) Every application for a licence shall be accompanied by the appropriate licence fee. Where the application for a licence is rejected a sum of rupees five thousand shall not be refunded.
 - (3) The Licensee shall also pay such relevant fee to effect the changes as specified hereunder-
 - (a) Upon a transfer of an Agency, for the inclusion of each principal in the licence-Rs. 10,000/-
 - (b) For the inclusion of a principal in the licence after the issuance of a licence.
(The fee paid shall not be refunded if the licence is refused). -Rs. 2,000/-
 - (c) For the issuance of a vessel-wise licence to handle a particular visit of a vessel belonging to a principal whose name is not included in the licence.
(The fee paid shall not be refunded if the licence is refused). -Rs. 1,000/-
